## Art

We believe at Denewood that every child deserves a holistic educational experience which extends to the subject of art. Art is a subject that helps us to understand and find meaning in the world we live in. Art is an essential subject that affects everyone's life in some way. Our objective is to support our pupils to aspire creatively through learning experiences practically and aesthetically. The curriculum that we provide is rich in skills and knowledge. Through our curriculum we aim to combine practical skills and creative thinking which in turn can develop transferrable skills for future careers.

Through our art curriculum our pupils are taught about formal elements; the fundamental building blocks of art, they are: line, colour, texture, pattern, tone, space, form. Pupils are not only taught how to use the elements in their work but how to use them with great communicative visual



effect. Pupil experience a variety of media, techniques and processes over their studies. In KS3 pupils will develop their skills and understanding with progressive complexities.

We support our pupils and encourage them to show good practice and learn from each other. We strongly promote looking at the work of others and celebrate other cultures and diversity; we provide opportunity for pupils to develop their perception of how art impacts society and to apply them and combine skills from the wider curriculum and with those from art to produce original artwork.
