

TOPIC

Topic builds on the skills and knowledge delivered in KS2. Within Topic we will be looking at three main areas of interest.

Geography- At Denewood, the Geography curriculum will provide an opportunity for pupils to develop their curiosity about the world and its various cultures and wonders. Pupils will deepen their understanding of local culture and how the interaction between physical and human processes.



History- Within History lessons, pupils will enhance their the social, economic, and political challenges human society has faced over the years.

This will support their growing knowledge of their local area and the world around them. This will



also support their understanding of chronological timeframes, people, and advancements in technology. With this in mind, we will embed trips and visits to fully immerse pupils in their experience of the curriculum area.

Ethics — Within the Citizenship and Ethics curriculum, pupils will enhance their understanding on being a law-abiding British citizen promoting British values and supporting their moral compass. Ethics will challenge them on their social, economic, and political stance in the



world stretching and challenging them. We will take part in debates, discussions, and project style work.

Religious education- Our aim is to extend pupil's understanding of religious and non-religious world views. We have designed this through our PSHE and Topic curriculum aiming to deepen their understanding of important beliefs, concepts and issues of truth and authority in specific religions. We also cover religious regions, religious ecology, religion and society and religious landscapes through Geography History and ethics.
